The Mons and Borinage Cross-Cultural Centre (CIMB) is one of 8 Regional Integration Centres in Wallonia. It aims to promote the integration of foreign nationals residing in the area of their jurisdiction.



During an interview, as part of their **pathway to integration**, the CIMB can:

- answer your questions about your rights and obligations in Belgium, your residential status (ID card), an application for naturalisation, etc.
- advise you regarding the regional support services available (housing, health, education, migrant associations, social and cultural activities, etc.)
- guide you towards resources to learn French, even for those who do not know how to read and write in their own language, and training where you can learn how Belgian society works (citizenship training)
- support you in finding a job (assist you in writing a CV and cover letter, help you to obtain a qualification certificate of equivalence, direct you towards suitable training and integration services, etc.)



Certain individuals will be required to follow an integration pathway. This mainly applies to refugees and non-European nationals in family groups with non-European nationals, but any foreign national can complete this course if they wish to do so.

Rights and obligations



There are trade unions available in Belgium to protect your employment rights.

Their remit covers the following areas:

- To advise you regarding social legislation
- To support your legal defence against an employer
- To process the payment of your unemployment allowance
- Unemployment allowance is calculated by the National Employment Office [Office National de l'Emploi (ONEM)], who then instructs the employment union to process the payment.
- To assist you with the availability and job seeking efficacy checks conducted by the ONEM.


